## **WARNING SIGNS**

- · Direct threats of self-harm
- Dramatic change in mood
- Increased use of drugs and alcohol
- Social Isolation
- Loss of a loved one to suicide



## **HOW TO HELP**

**ASK:** Don't be afraid to ask the question out loud - Are you thinking about suicide?

LISTEN: Allow the person to tell you how they feel, make eye contact and listen.

**REFER:** Be prepared to share the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline.
